Steve is very involved with the Portuguese Water Dog Club of America and the betterment of the breed in America. He has been a past board member, has served as President, was instrumental in the development of the Illustrated Breed Standard and is currently serving on both the Judge's Education and Breeder Development Committees. He is also involved with numerous local all-breed clubs.

Steve has been judging Portuguese Water Dogs since 2005. He has judged numerous specialties including the National Specialties in the United States and Canada, and is once again judging the PWDCA's National Specialty in 2023.
